• **THE WELL (paid in full!)**

- ✓ A company called *Water Giant Africa* will be drilling a well on the Development Team property the end of March
- ✓ Application for electrical permit/installation to the Development Team is being made
- ✓ A storage shed is being built to house garden tools and the electric panel for the well
- ✓ Banana seedlings are being purchased and will be planted on the Development Team acre very soon
- ✓ A 10,000 liter water tank and stand will be purchased soon to place near the well



• **DENIS & SARAH COLINS**

- ✓ The land Say Yes purchased for them is now ready to be cleared. Denis has a plan as to where to place the rabbit business, his own house, and the future daycare business.



• **PAUL & LETICIA MUKISA**

- ✓ Paul led a young man (Christopher) to the Lord and has been mentoring him ever since – even working with him to make bricks to sell so he could go back to school.
- ✓ The very bricks Paul helped Christopher make will be used to build a security wall in his backyard to secure the chickens and turkeys that are increasing by leaps & bounds!
- ✓ Pigs are producing left and right at the farm and he is now able to buy and plant more banana seedlings.
- ✓ Paul is currently reaping a harvest of bananas he planted last year!



• **SAM & RACHAEL**

- ✓ The acre Say Yes purchased for them right next to the Development Team land is cleared and ready for planting.
- ✓ Sam has led more young men to the Lord in the brick yard and is actively helping them start their own businesses. He invites them to help him in the tomato garden on the two acres he has rented and when they reap the harvest he promises to share the profits with them – enough so that they are able to start their own business. In the meantime, he disciples them in the ways of Jesus and shows them how to run a business.



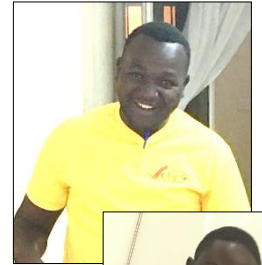
- **LYDIA**

- Sam & Rachael – vanilla and banana seedlings for their one acre of land
- Denis Buyinza – a structure to cover the car repair work when it rains & a gate to secure the compound
- Edith – maternity bed and two regular exam beds
- Say Yes – more partners
- Virgil & Joy – sufficient finances for an extended stay of 4-5 months in Uganda
